

Quality of Teaching Learning and Assessment

- High expectorations for all learners
- Subject knowledge for age group taught
- Aware of what learners; understand, know and can do
- Use assessment to ensure all make progress
- Feedback ensures pupils know how to improve
- Parental engagement
- Equality and diversity are respected

#### How do governors know?


- Recognising the vital role of selfevaluation
