





The knowledge, skills and behaviours needed for effective governance in maintained schools, academies and multi-academy trusts

January 2017



Key messages





- understanding the Core Functions is crucial;
- Nolan Principles underpin our work;
- engaging in professional development is essential;
- asking the right questions characterises effective governance;
- is our structure fit-for-purpose?
- what lessons have we learn during the pandemic?



Lessons learnt from the pandemic (so-far)

- shorter meetings are possible and can be productive;
- headteacher workload is a reality and governance can impact on this;
- preparation is everything;
- we must all guard against losing inclusive practice;
- Informed governors make informed decisions.



Key themes for governance this term:

- Pupil performance must be on the agenda;
- Changes in safeguarding expectations (Keeping Children Safe in Education) including peer-on-peer sexual abuse;
- Outbreak Management Plans;
- Ofsted focus on the curriculum has not gone away.
