Our research has shown that governors reported the strongest development in providing accountability and challenge, asking questions, preparing for and attending board meetings and strategic planning. Governors were able to powerfully demonstrate how development in these skills had supported them in the workplace.

What's expected of school governors?

Full governing board meetings are generally held once a term, usually in the afternoon or evening. Our latest impact report showed that our volunteers spend an average of 7 hours a month on governing duties, and bring £9.9 million worth of value to schools every year.

Governors will need to read the information shared ahead of board meetings to be able to ask the right questions, and to effectively support and challenge the headteacher. Governors should visit the school to gain an understanding of the culture and ethos and to get the most out of the role. They'll also have the opportunity to meet children, parents, and teachers, and see the impact of their work first-hand.
