#### IGovS and why they exist.

- Originally a small Founder group set up a website and a Twitter account and the word spread through Social Media;
- All our members are ex-NLGs who decided not to reapply in Jun 2021 after identifying that new NLGs would largely focus on ERGs in failing schools;
- IGovS now consists of 30+ members covering the whole country, who all are committed to providing free advice, mentoring and coaching.



#### What IGovS do.

- Since we started operating in Sep 2021, through our website <u>www.independentgovernor.com</u>, 90+ requests for support have been received and passed to our members. No request has been turned down and 75% are still ongoing. These requests include but are not limited to:
  - Chair support/advice and help to find a new Chair;
  - Advice ref pay review for a HT or Senior Executives;
  - Remote grievance/complaints panels;
  - Keynote presentations to Governor events;
  - Support for a deferred inspection;
  - Strategic planning or Board restructures;
  - Supporting a new inexperienced team of governors;
  - Support to clerks and advice around the role of governance professionals;
  - Facilitating strategy/vision sessions;
  - Pre & post Ofsted planning and support.

Please note: Support from IGovS is free but if the person receiving our support requests it, some of our members have gone on to provide paid support e.g. External Reviews of Governance or if there is a need to travel substantial distances to provide face to face support. This is brokered with the individual IGovS member, not by IGovS.

#### How and where do IGovS operate

- IGovS are currently operating all over England as shown in this map;
- We can provide support or training remotely via emails, Zoom, Teams or phone calls.
- This can lead to face to face support or training if schools prefer.
- We add additional capacity to the system of support available through the new NLG system;
- We provide the support mentoring and coaching that is missing from the new NLG system;
- Our experience and knowledge has not been lost from Governance.
