

Our free-to-access service - the process

- 1. For access to our free-to-access matching service, register your governor vacancies online using <u>your personal dashboard.</u>
- 2.As volunteers apply organically via our website, we search for roles that match their requirements if your vacancy is suitable, we send them the details.
- 3.If the volunteer is interested in moving forward, we'll make an introduction via email.
- 4. You can then arrange a meeting with the volunteer at the school to talk more about the role.
- 5. Update us on progress via your personal dashboard and email responses.
- 6.Once placed, volunteers receive 12 months free access to GovernorHub Knowledge and we signpost to our free eLearning modules.
